

Your journey at Engaging Potential

Introductions - The Centre Manager will visit you and explain what Engaging Potential (EP) does and what you can expect from your time with us.

You will then be introduced to your mentor.

Lead in period - Your mentor will introduce you to the rest of the team. During this time you will start to build relationships, get to know each other and build a timetable around your needs and interests. We will also go through confidentiality agreements and other important paperwork.

Over the next four weeks you will meet the other young people, your timetable will increase as you try new things to include activities and tutoring sessions and you will have sessions with other team members.

After your lead in period you will continue to create action plans for your future, focus on your education and look into work experience possibilities.

We will be available for support and guidance every step of the way!

Moving on from Engaging Potential

Nearing the end of your time at EP staff will support you in your future plans. This may include moving onto further education, doing an apprenticeship or training.

At this point, together with the team, you should be able to reflect on your achievements and progress you have made at EP and you can access Continuing Potential for 3 months after leaving.
